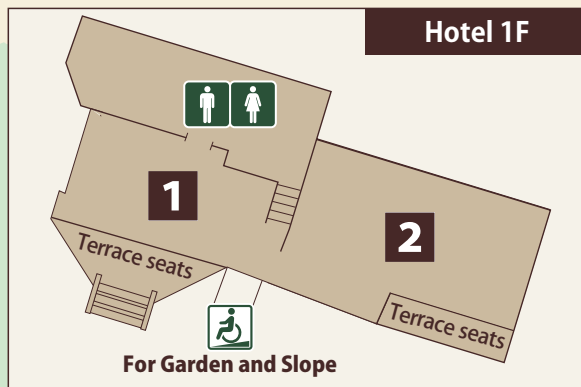
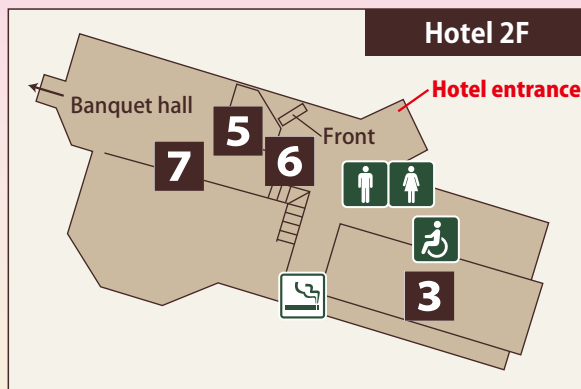
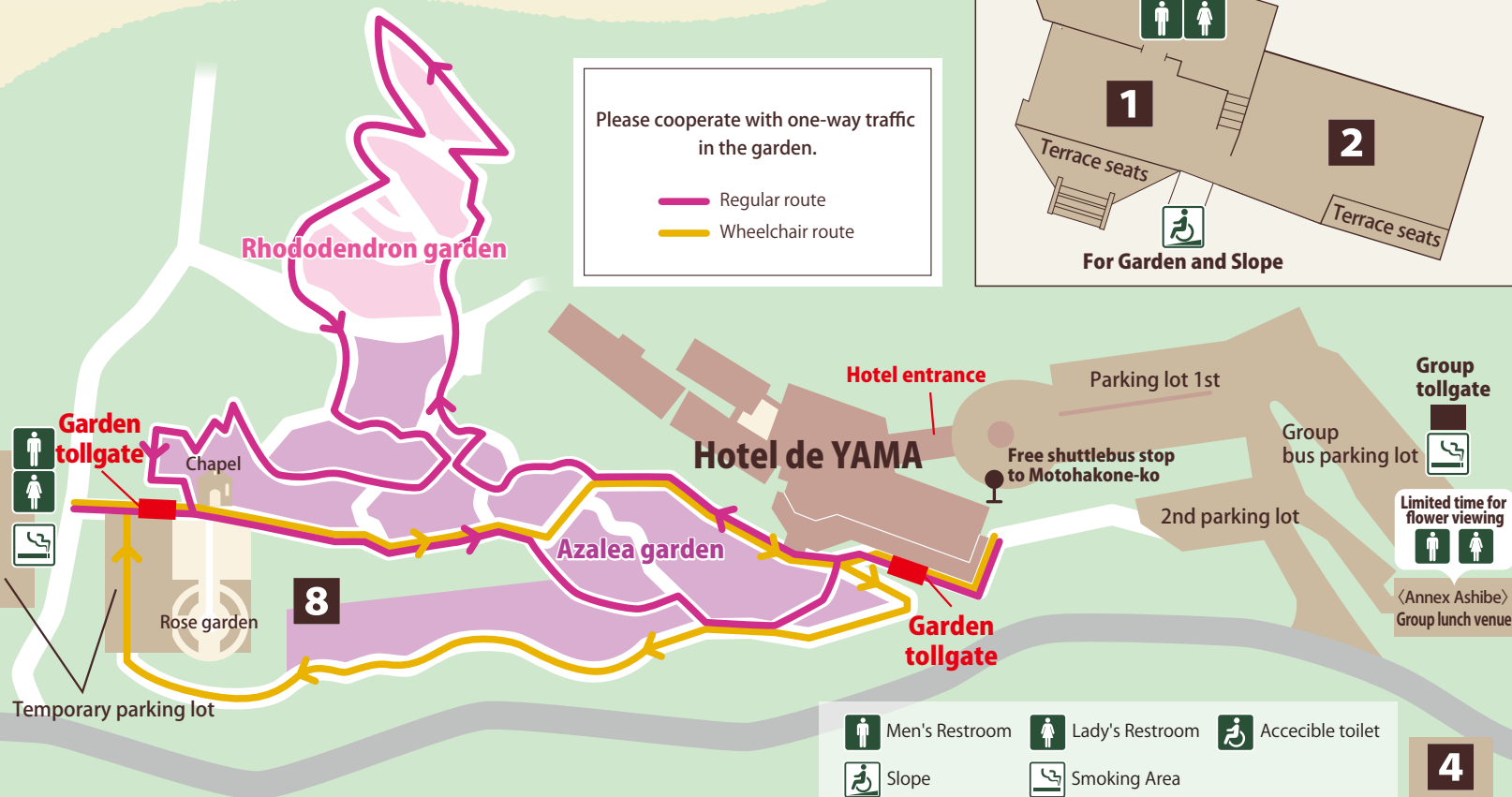


Late April to mid-May
